As part of this privatization, Systems Consultants expanded services is offering hunter application lists in the form of reports, labels, diskettes and CDs.

The expanded capabilities offer you the opportunity of purchasing specific lists in a variety of formats. If you have your own personal computer, you can even obtain machine-readable files suitable for processing with your database, spreadsheet or word processor.

These services are offered throughout the year with processing on a first-come, first-served basis. **However, all orders for the 2009 Main Draw information which are received prior to June 5, 2009, will receive priority handling and will be shipped to you via Express Mail so that you receive it by June 19, 2009, the official “Release” date for this information.***

The attached brochure gives you all the information you need to place your order. **Payment must be made in the form of a Money Order or Cashier’s Check, made payable to Systems Consultants.** Personal or company checks will not be accepted.

If you would like to place an order, please complete the attached order form(s) using the instructions included in the brochure. You may photocopy the form if you would like to place additional orders. Separate orders must be received for deer and trophy hunts.

2009 COMPUTER GENERATED PRODUCTS BROCHURE

Information Available:

- Successful applicants (for all or specific hunts and areas)
- All applicants (for all or specific hunts and areas)

Product Formats:

- Lists – Computer reports with applicant name, address, hunt and hunter choice information.
- Labels – Avery style peel labels with applicant name, address, hunt and hunter choice.
- Diskette Files – 3.5" PC DOS compatible ASCII files in space-delimited format, suitable for use with most databases (including dBase, R:Base, Paradox, FoxPro, Access, etc.), word processors (Word, WordStar, WordPerfect, etc.) and spreadsheets (Excel, Lotus, Symphony, etc.).
- Electronic Files – PC DOS compatible ASCII files in space-delimited format, eMailed directly to you. These files are identical to the Diskette Files listed above.
- Electronic Labels – Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF) labels eMailed directly to you. These can be printed on Avery Labels (format 5160) on a Laser or Inkjet printer.
- Electronic Lists – Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF) list eMailed directly to you. These can be printed on your printer.
- CDs – 650 MB capacity CD compatible ASCII files in space-delimited format, suitable for use with most databases (including dBase, R:Base, Paradox, FoxPro, Access, etc.), word processors (Word, WordStar, WordPerfect, etc.) and spreadsheets (Excel, Lotus, Symphony, etc.).

Ordering:

Use the attached order form (or photocopy) to request your order. See detailed explanations of your options for selecting portions of the entire file, with specifics about formats of each of the products on subsequent pages.

Payment must be in the form of a Money Order or Cashier's Check and must be made payable to Systems Consultants. Personal and company checks will not be accepted.

Pricing:

Prices quoted are guaranteed for all products ordered and delivered prior to December 31, 2009. Thereafter, prices are subject to change.

Selecting Information:

The first section of the order form allows you to specify the type of information you wish to select from the file. You can select the entire file of applicants. Historically, there have been in excess of 100,000 applications

each year. Alternatively, you can select only those people who are successful, or you can further refine your selection to specific hunts and even hunter choices.

First, you must identify whether you are selecting all applicants or just successful applicants. Next, you can pick one hunt or all hunts. If you don't want all hunts or just one hunt, but want to pick several hunts, you must complete a separate order form for each hunt.

Next, you can ask for only one label per hunter. For example, if you select all big game applications you will receive many duplicate labels because many hunters apply for more than one hunt. Next, you can specify the order in which your labels or disk files are sorted. The default sequence for labels and disk files is by zip code and within zip code, by name. This is to facilitate lower mailing costs. The default sequence for reports is by hunt and within hunt, by name. Finally, you can pick all hunter choices or specific hunter choices for the hunt you have selected. Note: If you pick all hunts, you may not pick specific hunter choices as hunter choices are tied to individual hunts.

For successful applicants, hunter choice will apply only to the hunter choices the applicant requested. Thus, if the applicant put in for hunter choices 644, 656 and 657 and you request a list of all applicants for hunter choice 656, the applicant will appear on the list. While it is less likely with this year's quotas, it is possible that you may specify a selection that results in no applicants appearing. For example, if you selected all antelope archery applicants in a particular hunter choice, it might be possible that there were no successful applicants in that hunter choice. You will be charged for your request regardless of the number of records that match your criteria.

Product Formats:

Information selected can be presented in a variety of formats, including:

- Paper Lists
- Paper Labels
- Diskette Files
- Electronic Files
- Electronic Labels
- Electronic Lists
- CDs

Examples and explanations for each format follow. Be sure you understand clearly what you are ordering and the consequences. If you select a format that you are unable to use without assistance (i.e., diskette or CD), Systems Consultants can only provide you this assistance on a time and materials consulting basis, using Systems Consultants' prevailing professional hourly rates. If you select a format that you are unable to use without assistance (i.e., diskette or CD) Systems Consultants must charge for its time and materials if you need personal professional assistance.

Paper Lists:

Paper Lists are computer reports that are produced on 8.5" x 11" paper using a laser printer. These reports are printed in landscape format (the paper is turned sideways so that the information appears horizontally along the longest edge of the paper). The printout uses eight lines per inch and a fixed typeface with 16.67 characters per inch. Printed pages will be bound for your convenience using heavy stock covers and a GBC plastic binding. Lists include the applicant name, address, status (successful or unsuccessful), hunt, area choices and successful area. Lists are useful if you wish to have a printed report to use for contacting individuals and to annotate your efforts. Lists are the least expensive paper product.

Paper Labels:

Paper Labels are generated on three-up Avery style computer labels. Labels are 1" x 2.5" and include five lines of information. The first line includes the hunt number and hunter choice (for successful applicants) and application status (4 = successful, 5 = unsuccessful, 7 = rejected). The hunt number, hunter choice and status will NOT be included if the "Eliminate Duplicates" option is selected. The second line is the applicant's name. The third line is the address and the fourth line is the applicant's city, state and zip code. When available, cleansed zip+4 codes are used.

Labels are useful for brochures, flyers and other announcements that you might want to send directly to applicants without having to address envelopes or mailing pieces. Labels can be printed in zip code sequence to allow you to take advantage of reduced mailing rates for pre-sorted pieces. Contact your local post office for details.

Diskette Files:

You can receive your list on 3.5" PC DOS compatible diskettes. If you are not a regular PC user and are not familiar with importing ASCII files into a word processor, database or spreadsheet, this format is NOT for you!

Files are produced in a flat ASCII-delimited format. This format is suitable for import into Lotus, dBase, Paradox, Access or other PC applications that accept comma-delimited formats. The file is compressed into a self-extracting "ZIP" file. When there is more data than will fit on a single diskette, the file is divided into separate files and placed on more than one diskette. Each line of the file is terminated with a carriage return and line feed and if duplicates are not eliminated, includes the applicant's first name, middle initial, last name, street address, city, state, zip code, hunt, hunter choices, status (successful or unsuccessful) and tag area (if successful). If duplicates are eliminated, the file will include the applicant's first name, middle initial, last name, street address, city, state and zip code.

If you have an eMail address, see the Electronic Files format which follows.

Electronic Files:

You can receive the Diskette Files described above, electronically via your eMail address. You will receive two eMails: One, with the files attached, and a second one, which provides the location of your files on our FTP site (and a personal password to allow you to download and utilize your files).

Electronic Labels:

You can receive your labels electronically via your eMail address. You will receive two eMails: One, with the labels attached, and a second one, which provides the location of your labels on our FTP site (and a personal password to allow you to download and utilize your labels). The electronic labels are in the form of an Adobe Acrobat Portable Document File (PDF) that can be viewed and printed with the free Adobe Acrobat Reader product downloadable from the Adobe site). The labels are formatted for printing on Avery Format 5160 label stock (8.5" x 11" three-up pressure sensitive labels, 30 to a page). This label stock can be printed on standard laser and Inkjet printers, but is not appropriate for dot matrix printers. If you are unfamiliar with using Acrobat PDF files or don't have a laser or Inkjet printer and Avery Format 5160 labels, this product is NOT for you!

Electronic labels are convenient as you can receive them electronically without waiting for Express Mail delivery and you can print them as many times as you wish.

Electronic Lists:

You can receive your list electronically via your eMail address. You will receive two eMails: One with the list attached and a second one which provides the location of your list on our FTP site (and a personal password to allow you to download and utilize your list). The electronic list is in the form of an Adobe Acrobat Portable Document File (PDF) that can be viewed and printed with the free Adobe Acrobat Reader product (downloadable from the Adobe site). The list is formatted for printing in landscape format on 8.5" x 11" paper. This is standard for typing paper or copier paper that can be printed on standard laser and Inkjet printers but is not appropriate for dot matrix printers. If you are unfamiliar with using Acrobat PDF files or don't have a laser or Inkjet printer, this product is NOT for you!

Electronic Lists are convenient as you can receive them electronically without waiting for an Express Mail delivery and you can print them as many times as you wish.

CDs:

You can receive your list on a CD, which can be read by most microcomputers.
